

Preapproved ADU Plan Review Submittal Checklist

This checklist details initial plan review only submittal and the components of an application for Preapproved ADU plan review. These records will bear the MP-prefix. MP-records are not building permits, they are plan review only records. Only after the MP/ADU- is reviewed and approved can step two begin with application for building permit. These applications marry a specific parcel with a specified approved master/ADU preapproved design.

Plan Review Applications must be submitted electronically.

<input type="checkbox"/>	<input type="checkbox"/>	The first step is to submit the ADU Plan Review via the Public Permit Portal to acquire Building Permit Submittal Clearance from the Planning Division by creating an <i>Online Planning Application (PLN)</i> record. Planning intake staff then reviews the submittal package and forwards it to the Building Division for review by automatically creating a <i>Building Submittal record (SUB)</i>		
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ELECTRONIC PLAN CHECK* IS REQUIRED FOR ALL PLAN REVIEW SUBMITTALS AND RESUBMITTALS.
