PROJECT: COTTON LANE APARTMENTS PROJECT(P24-022)

COMMENT PERIOD: December 5, 2024, to January 6, 2025

The project site consists of one vacant parcel totaling approximately 1.63 LOCATION:

> acres generally located south and west of West Stockton Boulevard, north of Cotton Lane, and east of Bruceville Road in the City of Sacramento,

California (Assessor's Parcel Number [APN: 117-0182-009-0000]

The City of Sacramento, Community Development Department, Environmental Planning Services has completed the preparation of a Draft Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Cotton Lane Apartments Project [P24-022] and intends to present the document along with a mitigation monitoring program (MMP) for adoption as part of project review. The IS/MND has been prepared in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).

The document is now available for a 30-day public review and comment period. The comment period is from December 5, 2024, to January 6, 2025. You may review a copy or obtain the document at the City's website located at:

The proposed project consists of a request of a Rezone from the Single-Unit Dwelling or Duplex Dwelling (R-1A) zone to the Multi-Unit Dwelling (R-3A) zone and to construct a 54-unit apartment complex in the single-unit dwelling or duplex dwelling (R-1A) zone on approximately 1.63-acres.
