sanctuary



The Sacramento City Council voted unanimously to declare the California capital a **“sanctuary city for transgender people.”**

It ensures that no city resources will be used to criminalize trans people seeking transition-related care or to cooperate with jurisdictions seeking to enforce laws that criminalize the care elsewhere.

Melissa Muganzo used her platform and agency to turn a severe health challenge into a community love offering that provides a voice to other who also suffer with unseen health and medical challenges.

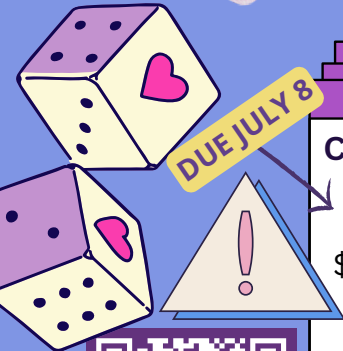
