Democracy and the systems that support your quality of life need your input. Voting is a MASSIVE and important step twards civic engagement, but it often overshadows the truth; you can have an impact, right now, every week, in your community, by attending council and meeting with your representatives.

A NOTE ON YOUR POWER

FINDING EFFECTIVE WAYS TO BE HEARD CAN BE EXHAUSTING

I have spent my residency learning this; there is too much information out there. It can take time and resources to get familiar with how everything at the city or county works. How can all of us overcome this barrier?

What is within your power? Active Participation.

The best and most impactful way to be heard is to come to council in person, talk to your representatives and city employees face to face. Submit a comment online, and share your opinions of agenda items that affect you; before decisions are made.

YOU DONT GET PAID FOR YOUR CIVIC ENGAGEMENT

It's true, mostly your ability to show up and advocate is up to you, your schedule and, your transportation. That's were advocating for better public transit, better accessibility, and better communication are important.

Lets build a community where we remove barriers to access. Change starts with those that do have access committing to action.

HOW CAN I MAKE AN IMPACT WITH LIMITED TIME AND RESOURCES?

Leave a comment at council. Ask Local News Media to cover council meetings. Sign up for the City of Sacramento Express so you know when items at council that are relevant to you are on the agenda. Watch the granicus website for recordings of the most recent meeting. Leave a public comment online from your home. Attend a council meeting and speak face to face with your commission and council members on matters that are important to you.

While the national election brews, now more than ever, it is important to understand the relevance of local council and mayoral elections- this is where your quality of life is decided. Your voice is LOUD at council because its local, because very few people attend, and fewer people speak up. Show up in person, leave a comment online; your voice is documented for historical record, shared with your representatives before they make decisions, and relied on as a guiding light.

Removing access barriers for other community members, friends, and family by offering rides, links to surveys, and information about upcoming opportunities can increase needed representation in institutional spaces.
