## What is Elder Fraud?

Seniors are increasingly being targeted by scammers looking for financial gain. Perpetrators attempt to gain access to funds or property through a variety of methods, including:

-  **Grandparent scam**
-  **Tech support scam**
-  **Utility or gift card scam**
-  **Home repair scam**
-  **Family/caregiver scam**
-  **Romance scam**
-  **Government impersonation scam**
-  **Sweepstakes/charity/lottery scam**
-  **TV/radio scam**
-  **Investment scam**

Note: In 2023, the FBI's Internet Crime Complaint Center (IC3.gov) received reported fraud of losses of \$3.4 billion from people 60 and older.
