Incident Summary

Officers McMahan and Goodpaster responded to the CHP station at 6 Massie Ct. regarding a possible domestic violence incident. Upon their arrival, the male subject (later identified as Anderson, Frank) was already detained in handcuffs by the CHP officers.

S-Anderson was uncooperative and appeared intoxicated. S-Anderson was detained in the back seat of Off. McMahan's police car. While seated, Off. McMahan re handcuffed s-Anderson and gave the other handcuffs back to the CHP officers who had detained him.

Off. McMahan performed a records check of s-Anderson and found him to be on parole for 2800 VC and 191.5 PC.

Off. Goodpaster took a statement from the female party (v [REDACTED]) and discovered that s-Anderson was arrestable for 273.5 PC.

Off. McMahan called the parole agent of s-Anderson to get a parole hold placed on him. While on the phone with the parole agent, Off. McMahan noticed that s-Anderson had been able to step through his handcuffs, and they were now in front of him.

Off. McMahan enlisted the help of Off. Goodpaster to re handcuff s-Anderson. The officers kept s-Anderson inside the car with his back to them. As Off. McMahan attempted to reconnect the right hand to the left, s-Anderson kept his right hand just out of reach of Off. McMahan. It seemed that s-Anderson was trying to draw Off. McMahan into the back seat with him.

Off. McMahan maintained some distance and did not get sucked into the back seat. S-Anderson pulled away and faced Off. McMahan with his fists clenched and a handcuff still attached to his left wrist. S-Anderson attempted to step out of the back seat of the car.

Off. McMahan drew his baton and jabbed s-Anderson twice in the chest. S-Anderson continued to try to get out of the car and was able to stand up. Off. McMahan struck s-Anderson approximately two more times. S-Anderson attempted to take the baton away from Off. McMahan. Off. McMahan was able to retain the baton, but s-Anderson was able to get all the way out of the police car.

S-Anderson began running South. Off. Goodpaster grabbed s-Anderson's left arm (still handcuffed) while Off. McMahan took s-Anderson to the ground. Even with Off. Goodpaster on his left arm and Off. McMahan on his back, s-Anderson was able to push up off of the ground.

S-Anderson was still armed with the handcuff on his left wrist. Off. McMahan's radio detached from his duty belt and was out of reach. Off. McMahan was concerned that s-Anderson would be able to fully regain his feet and use the handcuff as a weapon. Off. McMahan positioned himself in a Carotid Control Hold and applied the hold to s-Anderson. S-Anderson briefly went unconscious, then recovered before the officers were able to handcuff him. Off. McMahan applied the Carotid Control Hold again, and this time the officers were able to handcuff him.

S-Anderson quickly regained consciousness again. Other officers arrived on scene and held s-Anderson down until SFD medic was able to place s-Anderson in full restraints and transport him to the hospital for medical clearance.

Much of the incident was captured on Off. McMahan's ICC. This use of force was within policy.

On 05-02-13 at 1932 hours Ofc Goodpaster and I were dispatched to 6 Massie Ct, CHP South Sacramento, regarding a battery that just occurred. CHP Officer R Womack #17134 and CHP Officer Courtnier #16895 had detained two persons, later identified as S/Anderson and V/ [REDACTED] in the front parking lot of the CHP office. I arrived on scene at 1940 hours and contacted Ofc Womack and S/Anderson.

S/Anderson was in handcuffs. Ofc Womack relayed to me that S/Anderson was belligerent and uncooperative when he contacted him. Ofc Womack stated that he handcuffed S/Anderson for his safety. I asked S/Anderson what happened and why his nose was bleeding. S/Anderson stated that he had been arguing with his wife, V/ [REDACTED] S/Anderson stated he was walking and he fell on the ground and landed on his face. I observed that S/Anderson was wearing a white shirt and it was clean from stains except for a few drops of blood on his shirt. (See S/Anderson's statement.)

While I was talking to S/Anderson I observed that he had a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his person. His eyes were glassy and bloodshot. S/Anderson was not cooperating while I was asking him what happened to cause his bloody nose. At this point I decided to detain S/Anderson for 647(F) PC Drunk in Public hold.

I escorted S/Anderson to my patrol car. I searched S/Anderson and removed his items from his pockets. I located a 200 ML bottle of Crystal Palace Vodka that was half full in his left front pant pocket. I placed S/Anderson in the back of my patrol car. I removed Ofc Womack's hand-cuff's and placed mine on S/Anderson. I check the handcuffs for fit and double-locked them.

I ran a record check on S/Anderson and discovered that he was on active parole for a violation of 2800 VC and 191.5 VC through 03-19-14. I ran S/Anderson in LEADS 2.0. I discovered that it was a violation of S/Anderson's parole status to consume alcohol.

I spoke to Ofc Goodpaster and asked about V/ [REDACTED] statement. Based on [REDACTED] statement to Ofc Goodpaster we made the decision to arrest S/Anderson.

I called the 24 hour parole operator to obtain a parole hold. I gave the operator S/Anderson's information. I told the operator that S/Anderson was under arrest for 273.5 PC and that he was in possession of alcohol.

As I was talking to the parole operator I noticed that S/Anderson slipped his handcuffs to the front. I told Ofc Goodpaster what happened so she could assist me in removing one of the cuffs and placing the handcuffs behind S/Anderson.

I had S/Anderson move his hands to where I could grab them without opening the door the entire way. I cracked the door open and grabbed S/Anderson's left wrist. With my training and experience as a police officer I know that a suspect that has slipped their handcuffs from back to front is a dangerous situation. The handcuffs can be used as an impact weapon, to strangle with the links, or to grab and grip with the link.

I placed a firm control hold his left wrist. I uncuffed his right hand. I told S/Anderson to turn his front away from me toward the middle of the patrol car. S/Anderson only partially turned his body the direction I wanted. I told Anderson to give me his right hand. S/Anderson started to bring his right hand but then stopped. I was not willing to put myself in danger and commit myself to the interior of the car to handcuff Anderson. Anderson was leaning and slightly pulling his left arm toward the inside of the patrol car. I felt that Anderson was trying to pull me into the rear seat of the patrol car with him.

S/Anderson pulled away from me and rotated his body towards me. I observed that S/Anderson had both of his fists clenched and was now armed with the handcuffed that was on his left wrist. S/Anderson leaned forward and started to come out of the back-seat of the patrol car. I drew my baton from the ring and did two thrust jabs to the left side of his chest.

S/Anderson continued to rush towards me from the back seat. S/Anderson had both of his feet on the ground and was trying to pull himself from the patrol car. I repositioned my baton in my hands to the guard position. I pushed at and struck Anderson with my baton two more times. Anderson grabbed my baton with both of his hands and violently tried to pull it away from me. I struggled with Anderson and to maintain control of my baton for 3-4 seconds. I rotated my left hip, so I did not present my handgun to him, and used my body to pull my baton away from him.

At this point S/Anderson made it out of the patrol car. Ofc Goodpaster deployed her ESB but did not have an opportunity to strike Anderson due to the patrol car door and my body position.

Ofc Goodpaster got on her portable radio and requested additional officers to assist us.

S/Anderson began to run to the south. Ofc Goodpaster was able to grab Anderson's left hand to prevent him from using the handcuffs as a weapon. I grabbed Anderson by his left shoulder and tried to push him down to the ground. I had my baton in my right hand as I did not have time to return it to the ring. While I was trying to prevent Anderson from escaping my baton got knocked from my hand as we fell to the ground.

I was able to push S/Anderson to the ground. S/Anderson was face down on the ground and I was on his back. I observed out of the corner of my eye that my baton was 3-4 away on the ground. Ofc Goodpaster had S/Anderson's left arm. I could feel S/Anderson trying to push up and keep fighting. I felt concerned that if S/Anderson was able to return to his feet he would be able to fight with Ofc Goodpaster and me or try and flee the area. I felt that it could be a potentially lethal situation since Anderson had the handcuff on his wrist and could use that as an impact weapon. I repositioned my body on top of S/Anderson and applied the carotid control hold. I felt S/Anderson go limp and exhale loudly. I held to hold until I felt his body relax underneath mine. S/Anderson has right arm under his body. I wanted to try and grab his right arm so Ofc Goodpaster and I could finish handcuffing him. I went to grab his right arm and I could feel Anderson tense up and began to push up again. I re-applied the carotid control hold until I felt his body go limp.

Ofc Tippets, Ofc Knoblock, and Ofc Trejo arrived on the scene. I maintained my control hold position on Anderson. I told the officers that were there to put on their gloves before touching Anderson because he was bleeding from his nose. Ofc Tippets, Ofc Knoblock, and Ofc Trejo assisted in handcuffing S/Anderson.

I told Ofc Goodpaster to request an ambulance for S/Anderson since I used the carotid control hold. During the struggle S/Anderson had ripped my radio from my duty belt and I was unable to use it.

Ofc Goodpaster requested CSI.

Engine 7 and Medic 7 arrived on the scene. S/Anderson was taken to Kaiser South for treatment.

I booked the bottle of vodka into evidence at JERPF.

(S) Anderson and I have been married for 2 years. We have been separated for about a year or so. I even filed for divorce. We have problems because of his drinking. We recently began talking again and talked about getting back together. (S) Anderson and I decided we would try dating again and take it slow.

Tonight was supposed to be the first date. I was supposed to meet him over here on Massie Ct to go skating from 6-9 PM. I was running late and didn't get here until close to 7:10 PM. I could tell right away he had been drinking.

I told (S) Anderson that it was supposed to be our first date and he was going to go and get drunk. I told him that is why we have so many problems. I decided I was going to go inside and skate anyway. I walked inside and there were too many people wanting to play basketball so there was no skating.

On 5-2-13 at 1932 hrs I, Ofc Goodpaster #446 (1C52), was dispatched to 6 Massie Ct (CHP South Office) in regards to a physical fight between a male and a female. The call stated that the male had blood on his face. I arrived at 1941 hrs. I saw three CHP officers on scene and the female (later identified as (V) ██████████) and the male (later identified as (S) Anderson, Frank) was sitting on the curb and appeared to be handcuffed.

I spoke with (W) Ofc Courtnier#16895 and obtained his statement (see attached). Ofc McMahan #859 (1C54) spoke with the other officers on scene and took custody of (S) Anderson. Ofc McMahan detained (S) Anderson in the rear of his patrol vehicle.

I spoke with (V) ██████████ and obtained her statement (see attached). She stated she had been hit in the back of the head but there was no visible injuries.

While speaking with (V) ██████████ Ofc McMahan advised me that (S) Anderson had "slipped" his handcuffs; meaning that he had moved the handcuffs from behind his back to in front his body. I went to Ofc McMahan's patrol vehicle and spoke with (S) Anderson and advised him that he needed to put his hands back behind his back as Ofc McMahan had done when he was seated in the vehicle. (S) Anderson was using his hands to wipe blood from his nose and stated he needed help with wiping the blood away. I advised him that I would not wipe blood off his face. (S) Anderson had fresh blood on his hands from his nose.

Ofc McMahan and I advised (S) Anderson that we would be opening the door and putting his handcuffs behind his back once again. Ofc McMahan opened the rear door and (S) Anderson began to step out of the vehicle and Ofc McMahan advised him that he was to remain in the vehicle. (S) Anderson raised his hands in front of his body for Ofc McMahan to adjust the handcuffs.

Ofc McMahan removed the right hand from the handcuffs and had a constant grip on the left wrist area which still had a handcuff on it. Ofc McMahan had (S) Anderson in a one-handed rear wristlock as he was attempting to turn (S) Anderson away from him to re-handcuff him. (S) Anderson refused to place his right hand behind his back. Anderson yelled to stop twisting his arm. (S) Anderson began to place his right arm behind his back, but was out of the reach of Ofc McMahan. There was no room for me to reach in and assist Ofc McMahan due to the door being in the way.

(S) Anderson began to pull away from Ofc McMahan. I un-holstered my Expandable Straight Baton (ESB) and advised Ofc McMahan I had deployed it. Ofc McMahan released the control hold of (S) Anderson and took a step away from the patrol vehicle. Ofc McMahan un-holstered his wooden baton and struck (S) Anderson approx 2 times in the chest with a jab. (S) Anderson appeared to be unphased by the jabs. Ofc McMahan struck (S) Anderson approx 2 more times and he appeared to be somewhat compliant.

I gave (S) Anderson commands to lay on the ground. He refused to comply. (S) Anderson put a foot outside of the patrol vehicle and began to rush towards Ofc McMahan. Ofc McMahan used his wooden baton in the on guard position and attempted to push (S) Anderson back inside the patrol vehicle. The technique Ofc McMahan used is the same technique used in crowd control when we need to push a crowd back. (S) Anderson grabbed Ofc McMahan's baton and they began to struggle over it.

I was attempting to transition to my Conducted Energy Device (CED) to subdue (S) Anderson. As I was un-holstering my CED, (S) Anderson used the leverage of Ofc McMahan's baton to push Ofc McMahan aside and begin to run. Ofc McMahan quickly re-engaged (S) Anderson and attempted a take down from behind. (S) Anderson took approx 3-4 steps and fell to the ground with Ofc McMahan on his back. I took control of (S) Anderson's left hand and placed it in a 2 handed rear wristlock.

I requested more units to assist as (S) Anderson was on the ground and being combative. Ofc McMahan transitioned to the carotid control and began to apply pressure. I had (S) Anderson's left arm in the 2 handed rear wristlock and his right arm was under his body. Ofc McMahan applied the carotid control hold and I felt (S) Anderson's body go limp. I advised Ofc McMahan that (S) Anderson was out and less than 1 second later (S) Anderson was attempting to move his left arm from my control hold.

(S) Anderson was not compliant when I gave him commands to give us his right arm. Ofc McMahan applied pressure for the carotid control hold again. I advised Ofc McMahan that (S) Anderson had began to bleed more once we were on the ground and he was combative.

Ofc McMahan and I held (S) Anderson on the ground until Ofc Knoblock, Ofc Tippets and Ofc Trejo arrived to assist in placing (S) Anderson in

handcuffs. (S) Anderson was handcuffed and Ofc Tippets placed him in the position of recovery. (S) Anderson began to stand up and Ofc Tippets walked him towards the closest patrol vehicle. (S) Anderson began to resist Ofc Tippets and appeared to be trying to break free of his grip. Ofc Tippets took (S) Anderson back to the ground. I secured (S) Anderson's legs. Ofc Knoblock and Ofc Trejo placed a hobble on (S) Anderson's legs.

I requested code 3 fire due to the carotid control hold being applied to (S) Anderson and the blood coming from his nose. Truck 7 and Medic 7 arrived and transported (S) Anderson to Kaiser South for medical clearance. Ofc Pullen took custody of (S) Anderson and accompanied him in the medic.

I requested CSI to photograph (S) Anderson, Ofc McMahan and myself. Ofc McMahan had an abrasion on his left elbow approx 2 inches long and an inch wide. He also had abrasions on his knees. I had pain and swelling to my left middle finger. I also had abrasions to both knees and complaint of pain to my left knee. Truck 7 applied first aid to Ofc McMahan's injuries.

CSI Ofc Cruz arrived and took photographs of Ofc McMahan, myself and the scene.

Sgt Wann #3117 (3SM5) arrived and was notified of the circumstances.
