Incident Summary

On 1/19/13, at approximately 2301 Ofc. Montoya (1C58) and Ofc. Prather (GRN57) were dispatched t Lindbrook Way # regarding a welfare check of Leandro Gutierrez (DOB: 2/2/1970). Per the complainant on the call, Guiterrez was at the above address and had sent the complainant text messages that he was worried that his girlfriend was going to have him killed. It should be noted tha Lindbrook Way is immediately south of Kaiser South Hospital and responsibility for patrol and response to calls for service at this location is that of the of the Green Unit.

While enroute officers determined that there was an active DV restraining order against Gutierrez with a protected person by the name of (DOB) (DOB). The RO was issued out of Yolo County and stated that Gutierrez was to have no contact with (DOB). It was determined after the incident that the female victim/witness inside of (DOB) Lindbrook Way (DOB) (DOB) (DOB).

Officers arrived at 2303 Hrs. Officer Prather and Montoya knocked on the door of the apartment and announced that they were the police. They heard the door being unlocked but it was never opened. Ofc. Montoya then heard a male voice say something similar to, "I am going to kill you we are all going to die. The police are here to kill us. I am going to die tonight. I am going to get fucked up by the police."

Fearing for the life of the female inside the residence. Officers again announced their presence, demanded the door be opened. Officers heard a female voice say, "He is blocking the door and not letting me open it." They then announced they were going to force entry. Officer Montoya heard the door being locked from the inside and began to kick it. The door eventually gave way but could only be opened about 1 foot. Ofc. Montoya saw that Gutierrez was holding the door shut and preventing them from entering. Ofc. Montoya used his department issued pepper spray on Gutierrez through the opening but it had no effect on him. Ofc. Montoya drew his department issued CED in attempt to use it through the opening but Gutierrez put his hands in front of the CED to block its use and also attempted to take it from the officer. Additional officers responded and arrived on scene. The officers were eventually able to force the door open causing it to fall off of its hinges. Gutierrez fell to the ground and after a brief struggle was taken into custody with out incident. The following officers assisted with taking Gutierrez into custody: Yasonia, G. Martinez, Eggen, David Deleon, and Culp.

CSI responded and took photos of the suspect, door and officers.

This incident was not captured on ICC as Officers Prather and Montoya had not activated their in-car cameras. I reviewed the General Order 525.03 with both officers.

A canvas was completed.

Gutierrez was seen and cleared by Sacramento Fire Department at the scene. He was transported to Sacramento Co. Main Jail by Officers Hasagawa and Buchanan. He was not cleared by the intake nurse due to an elevated heart rate. He was transported to Sutter General Hospital where he admitted to having swallowed a "rock." The hospital also informed officers that Gutierrez possibly had three fractured ribs. Gutierrez was later released at the hospital per 849(b) PC by the next patrol watch. This was done because it was determined by hospital staff that he would need to remain at the hospital for at least another 24 hrs.

It was determined that when the door was originally forced open by the officers it struck **constants** in the face. She had a small cut and complaint of pain to her nose. After reviewing the report it appears that CSI photos were not taken of her injury. It was my responsibility to assure that these photos were taken and I failed to do so.

During the incident Officer Prather injured her right knee as a result of it striking the door. She completed a

first report (incident only). Officer Martinez stuck his left knee on the door causing a minor injury. He completed a first report (incident only). CSI took photos of the injuries.

I found this use of force to be justified and within policy.



To prevent GUTIERREZ from kicking officers, both his left and right ankles were secured in a hobble.

Officers carried GUTIERREZ to a police vehicle were he was placed into the back seat.

After the event I had slight pain to my right eye near my orbital bone. I observed a tear in my uniform pants, left leg. I also observed my baton holder had been tore from my duty belt. CSI responded and obtained photographs.

On Saturday 1/19/13 at approx 2310hrs, I Ofc. Yasonia (577) responded code 3 to Lindbrook Way. Officers on scene requested code 3 cover after a subject on scene refused to cooperate. I arrived on scene at approx 2311 hrs in full duty uniform and driving a marked patrol vehicle. I observed the following in summary:

Officers were running inside the building and upstairs to the third floor. When I ran upstairs I found officers forcing their way inside of the apartment. After the door broke of the hinges, Officers pulled (s) Gutierrez out of the apartment and into the hallway. Once he was on the ground, (s) Gutierrez began swinging his arms around making it difficult for officers to gain control over him. After approx 10 seconds I was able to gain control of his left arm. I held onto his left arm until Ofc. Montoya was able to place a handcuff on it. I pulled his left arm behind his back were Ofc. Deleon had his right arm. We placed his right arm into a handcuff and he continued yelling and screaming.

While I was holding (s) Gutierrez down on the ground he grabbed onto my duty belt, I was able to get his hand off if my magazine pouch and used a two hand rear wrist lock to control his arms and hand.

On 1/19/13 at approximately 2310 hours I, Ofc. T. Culp #858, heard GRN57 (Officer P. Prather #261) call for Code 3 Cover over the radio. I had no other additional information regarding the circumstances surrounding Ofc. Prather's Cover Call. I responded to her location (Lindbrook Way) Code 3 and observed the following in summary:

As I arrived on scene Ofc. D. Deleon #716, Ofc. G. Martinez #400, and Ofc. C. Eggen #874 were arriving on scene. I heard a broadcast that Ofc. Prather was on the 3rd floor of the apartment complex.

Ofc. D. Deleon #716, Ofc. G. Martinez #400, Ofc. C. Eggen #874 and I entered the apartment complex building. We ran up to the 3rd floor. There was a door that lead from the stair way to the 3rd floor. As I entered the 3rd floor from the stair way I observed Ofc. Prather struggling in the partially open door of apartment . I couldn't tell if some one on the other side was trying to pull Ofc. Prather into the apartment or push her out. I observed Ofc. D. Montoya #212 standing directly behind Ofc. Prather.

I observed Ofc. G. Martinez #400 try to push open the door. I could see that he was un-able to push the door open. Ofc. C. Eggen #874 and I began

to push the door with Ofc. G. Martinez. As we pushed the door the hinges began to separate from the door frame and the door broke open.

As the door fell to the ground I observed the subject that was standing on the other side. I observed a male, Hispanic, adult (later identified as (S) Leandro Gutierrez) yelling, "I'm sorry Lord." I could see that (S) Leandro Gutierrez had something in his had, but couldn't tell what it was. I observed that just beyond the front door there was a hallway. At the end of the hallway I observed a female, White, adult (later identified as (S)

. I could only partially see the room she was standing in and could not tell if anyone else was inside the apartment. I observed that was screaming and appeared to be crying. I observed that appeared to have some sort of injury to her face.

Ofc. Eggen and I grabbed (S) Leandro Gutierrez. (S) Leandro Gutierrez was pulling away from us. I heard Ofc. Eggen say, "lets pull him outside." Ofc. Eggen and I pulled (S) Leandro Gutierrez out the front door. Other Officers that were on scene grabbed (S) Leandro Gutierrez as Ofc. Eggen and I pushed him out of the apartment. I saw (S) Leandro Gutierrez and the Officers go to the ground.

I observed Ofc. Z. Yasonia #577 trying to get (S) Leandro Gutierrez into a control hold. I heard Ofc. Z Yasonia say, "Stop grabbing me."

I saw Officers struggling with (S) Leandro Gutierrez on the ground. I turned and covered the apartment in case there were any threats inside the apartment.

Once the Officers had placed (S) Leandro Gutierrez into hand-cuffs I heard some one ask for a hobble. I used my hobble to restrain (S) Leandro Gutierrez's feet together.

I assisted in carrying (S) Leandro Gutierrez out of the apartment complex and helped placed him in the back seat of a patrol vehicle.

I observed that the right side of my jacket had been torn. CSI responded and took photos of my torn jacket.

On Saturday 01-19-13 at approx. 2301 hrs. I (Ofc. Montoya)(1c58) was dispatched along with Ofc. Prather (Grn57) to Lindbrook Way regarding a welfare check of a subject. Per the text of the call the complainant was with his Aunt who received text messages from her nephew Gutierrez, Leandro (DOB:02-02-60) which stated he felt threatened by his girlfriend (unknown further) and that she was going to have him killed. We responded in full SPD uniform and driving marked patrol vehicles. We arrived on scene at approx. 2303 hrs.

Prior to arriving on scene A records check revealed that there was an active domestic violence restraining order (DVRO) against Gutierrez with the protected person being **Control of County** (Exp:08-03-14) Per the DVRO Gutierrez was to have no contact with **County**.

Upon arrival on scene Ofc. Prather and I knocked on the door several time and announced ourselves as the police. I could hear shuffling and talking from inside the from a male and female inside, with no response. Again we announced ourselves as the police and knocked on the door harder. I then

heard a chain and lock being removed from the door but the occupants never opened the door.

Through the door I then heard male voice say something to the effect of "I am going to kill you _____, We are all going to die, the police are hear to kill us. I am going to die tonight, I am going to get fucked up by the police."

Again Ofc. Prather and I announced that we were the police and to open the door. A female voice then stated, "He is blocking the door and not letting me open it." I then heard what sounded like the door being re-locked with the dead-bolt.

Based on what I heard from the male inside, the female stating the male was blocking the door, the active DVRO and believing that the female may be in danger. I told the occupants to step away from the door and that I was going to kick the door in (force entry). I used a front kick and stuck the door approx 3 times, before the door gave way. With each kick to the door I felt what I believed to be a subject standing on the other side of the door as with each kick the door would open approx 6 inches and then slammed closed. I stuck the door Approx 2 more times in an attempt to get the subject to move. Seeing that the door was no longer secured Ofc. Prather and I used our body weight to attempt to force the door open. We were able to open the door approx. 1.5 feet and I was able to wedge my head and shoulder so that the door could not close. Upon sticking my head through the open door I observed a MHA later identified as Gutierrez standing behind the door bracing himself against the wall with his hands in front of him and his back against the wall forcefully attempting to keep officers from entering.

Gutierrez stated that we were not the police and that we were only there to kill him.

NOTE: Once the door was open I observed that upon entering the apartment through the door there was an approx 6' hallway/entry which was approx 4-5' wide with a wall on each side, which led to the living room.

I then observed a FWA standing at the end of the hall. She stated that She was struck by the door when I initially forced entry. She began yelling at Gutierrez that we were the police and to let us in. She then stated that he was on drugs and not acting/thinking clearly.

Based on Gutierrez continuing to attempt to prevent officers from entering and the above circumstances, I deployed used my department issued pepper

spray in my right hand and stuck my arm around the door in an attempt that its effects would stop Gutierrez from holding the door closed. The pepper spray had little-no effect on Gutierrez.

At this time Ofc. Prather requested (Code 3 Cover) to have additional units respond to assist.

I then unholstered my department issued Conducted Energy Device (CED) and again sticking my right arm and head around the door attempted to us my CED on Gutierrez. I was unable to get a clear shot as Gutierrez repeatedly put his hands in front of my CED and attempted on at least to occasions to grab it. During this time Gutierrez was seated with his back against the wall and used his feet to continue to close the door on my. I was never able to get a clear/direct shot on Gutierrez's body so I did not deploy my CED at him.

A short time later Ofc. Deleon (1a55), Ofc. Eggen (1a52), Ofc. Martinez (Grn58), Ofc. Culp (1a51), Ofc. Yasonia (1a49) arrived to assist. Officer then used there body weight to force the door open tearing the door from its hinges. The door fell on top of Gutierrez. Gutierrez was removed from that apartment entry way into the exterior hallway where he was detained in handcuffs.

CSI was requested for photos of the door, Gutierrez's injuries and Officers injuries which occurred during the struggle.

Sac. Fire/ Medical was requested to treat Gutierrez for being pepper sprayed.

Ofc. Hasegawa and Ofc. Buchanan transported and booked Gutierrez into SCMJ for PC 273.6-DVRO violation, and PC 148(a)- Resist, Delay, Obstruct a peace officer.

Upon further investigation it was discovered that the female inside the apartment was actually and not the protected person issue inside the listed on the DVRO.

Gutierrez was subsequently rejected at SCMJ by nursing staff. He was transported to Sutter General Hospital.

Due to an extended wait at Sutter General Hospital Gutierrez was later released per PC 849(b) by Ofc. Wollman.

Sgt. Moore (3Sm4), Sgt. Pettit (3Sm5) and Sgt. Green (1SM5) was advised of

The call stated that the complainant's aunt had received messages from her son stating that he was afraid of his girlfriend IIIIII and that she was going to have him killed. The complainant further stated that the aunt's son, identified as Leandro "Roger" GUTIERREZ, stopped responding to his mother's messages and she was worried about him. I arrived on scene at 2306 hrs. Officer Montoya #212 arrived on scene to assist.

A records check of GUTIERREZ found a domestic violence restraining order against him, with **Sector** as the protected party. The order as issued on 7/14/2011 and will expire on 8/3/14.

Upon arrival on scene, Officer Montoya and I made several announcements and knocked on the door multiple times. I could hear a male and a female inside the apartment. The male sounded like he was on the phone, telling someone that "I am gonna get fucked up tonight," and "the police are here to kill me." He also said something like "I am going to kill someone." I heard the female say that the male had already hurt her earlier and that he was blocking the door so that she couldn't open it.

GUTIERREZ was yelling something, but I was calling for code 3 cover and did not hear what he was saying.

Officer Montoya deployed his pepper spray around the door in an attempt to subdue GUTIERREZ with negative results. GUTIERREZ was still resisting our efforts to open the door.

Additional officers arrived on scene and were able to knock the door off its hinges. GUTIERREZ was scooped up and brought out into the hallway. He continued to resist officers' efforts to detain him. GUTIERREZ was eventually taken into custody and placed in the back seat of a patrol vehicle.

I contacted 1SM5 (Sgt Green) and advised him of the call.
