### Incident Summary

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2/5/13 1649 hrs. Officers were dispatched to [REDACTED] street regarding a medical aid call. There was a M/W/A passed out in the complainants driveway. The subject's eyes were open, yet he was unresponsive.

Sacramento FD & responded code-3 to the scene. When the subject heard the sirens approaching, he got up and tried to fight the complainant. He then ran through the residential neighborhood.

Officer Stambaugh was hailed by a witness that stated the subject had just broke into the residence located a [REDACTED] Serra Way. The subject had broken the glass in the front door to gain entry. Officer Stambaugh quickly set-up a perimeter around the residence.

K9 Sgt. Oliviera responded to the scene. We coordinated a tactical search plan with his Police Service Dog along with an arrest team. The arrest team included Officers Bell, King, and Mann.

Sgt. Oliviera made numerous announcements over his P.A. system for the suspect to come out and surrender. There was no response to any of the announcements. K9 Sgt. Oliviera deployed his police K9 (Sig) to search the interior of the residence. Shortly thereafter, K9 Sig located the suspect hiding in a back bedroom. The suspect attempted to fight the K9 off but was quickly overcome. The arrest team took the suspect into custody without further incident.

Sacramento FD & Ambulance responded and transported the suspect to UCD Medical Center for medical treatment. The suspect was admitted to the hospital for further treatment to his injuries. Due to a lengthy stay at UCD/MC, he was released per 849b PC. Officers returned to the hospital the day he was to be released but were told he was not clear yet. Shortly thereafter, the suspect pulled out his I.V., other medical equipment and fled on foot from the hospital. A warrant request was submitted for his arrest.

The Use of Force was justified and within department policy. I reviewed the ICC recordings and noted no training issues.



On 2/05/13 at approximately 1649 hrs I, Ofc Stambaugh #565, responded to [REDACTED] T St regarding a medical aid call. Per text of the call, there was a male white adult passed out in the complainants driveway. The subject's eyes were open, yet he was non-responsive. Police and fire units were dispatched to check his welfare.

Upon my arrival, complainant [REDACTED] advised that just prior to my arrival, the subject had jumped up suddenly, lunged at him, and tried to fight him before running off toward Serra Way. [REDACTED] believed that the subject was high on drugs. [REDACTED] advised that the subject suddenly sprung up when told that police were on their way.

I obtained a description of the subject and also viewed a photo of the subject that [REDACTED] had taken on his cell phone. The subject appeared to be a male white adult in his 20's with brown hair and wearing a brown jacket.

I began checking the area for the subject. As I drove north on 32nd St from T St, another neighbor (witness [REDACTED]) began shouting and pointing at a house [REDACTED] of 32nd St/Serra Way. Witness [REDACTED] advised that the subject had just smashed the front door glass of [REDACTED] Serra Way and entered the residence.

I requested additional units and a perimeter around the house. Multiple units arrived on scene quickly and a perimeter was formed around the house. k-9 Officers also arrived on scene and made multiple PA announcements for the suspect to surrender but got no response.

After several minutes, suspect William Glover was taken into custody inside the house by K-9 Sgt Olivera and his K-9 partner. Glover was located in a bedroom on the southwest corner of the house. See Sgt Olivera's supplement for details.

I obtained a statement from victim [REDACTED], the owner of [REDACTED] Serra Way. She advised that she did not know Glover and he did not have permission to enter her residence (no one was home at the time of the break-in). She also advised that Glover had caused approximately \$3000 in damage to her home. I provided her with the report number for her records.

I also obtained witness statements from [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. Ofc Brown conducted a neighborhood canvass for additional witnesses, with negative results. Sgt. Olivera obtained a Mirandized statement from suspect Glover.

CSI Sgt Lockwood responded to the residence and to UCD for photos.

A records check on suspect Glover was negative in Sacramento County, although he did have an outstanding drug related warrant out of Ventura County (Ofc Brown called Ventura County and they advised that they would extradite, warrant # [REDACTED])

Suspect Glover was transported to UCD hospital for medical treatment/fit for incarceration clearance via ambulance. He will be charged with 459 PC, 148(a)(1) PC and his warrant.

3SM3, Sgt Chapman, was on scene and advised of the circumstances of the call.

#### SCENE:

[REDACTED] Serra Way is a single story 2 bedroom house located on the southeast corner of Serra Way/32nd St. The front door faces north.

On 2-5-13 at approx. 1656 hrs, I, Sgt. Oliveira (K9SM9), and my police service dog, K9 Sig, responded to the area of [REDACTED] Serra Wy regarding a possible burglary in progress. Officers were setting up a perimeter around the house and the suspect was believed to still be inside. I was in full police uniform and driving a marked K9 patrol vehicle. While enroute, I read the CAD call which showed the initial call involved a citizen reporting a male white adult lying on their driveway with his eyes wide open, but unresponsive. At approx. 1703 hrs, I arrived on scene and contacted Officer Stambaugh who was one of the first officers on scene. She advised that the suspect from the original call had gotten up, aggressively confronted the complainant and then ran off. Officer Stambaugh was checking the area for the suspect when she was flagged down by another neighbor who stated the suspect had just broken into a home at [REDACTED] Serra Wy. Officer Stambaugh observed the completely shattered window on the front door and immediately set up a perimeter around the house. The alarm on the house had also activated and the residents were not believed to be home.

At approx. 1712 hrs, I began making several loud K9 announcements on my PA system towards the broken door and NW corner of the house. I identified myself as the Sacramento Police K9 Unit, requested the suspect to surrender and come out of the house with his hands up or a K9 would be used to find him and he may be bit. There was no response. Officers on the rear perimeter advised they could hear the announcements loud and clear. At approx. 1720 hrs, I made additional K9 announcements on the PA with no response from the suspect. The announcements were recorded on my digital ICC. K9 Officer Hoversten contacted me on my cell phone and advised that the same residence had been recently burglarized. He also informed of an attic access in the hallway. Sgt. Chapman responded to the scene and I briefed him on the circumstances.

I made the decision to deploy K9 Sig to search for the suspect based on the following criteria:

- There was reasonable belief the suspect was committing a burglary (459 PC). The suspect forcibly entered the residence by shattering the front glass door and entering the residence setting off the burglar alarm. It was unknown if this was the same suspect that had previously burglarized the house.

- Numerous K9 warnings were given and the suspect was not complying with our direct orders to surrender.
- The suspect was unsearched and it was not known if he was armed with a firearm or other weapon. It was not clear if the suspect used some type of instrument to break the window. In addition the suspect now had access to house hold items such as kitchen knives that could be used as weapons against officers. It has also been my experience that burglars routinely steal firearms from residences and it was unknown if there were any firearms in this residence.
- The suspect was believed to be concealed inside the residence with numerous places to hide including an attic making it dangerous for officers to search without the use of a K9.
- I was also concerned the suspect may be under the influence of an illegal drug based on erratic behavior; lying on a stranger's driveway with eyes open but unresponsive, suddenly jumping up and confronting the complainant, running off on foot and breaking into another home through the front door in front of witnesses and staying in the residence with the alarm sounding. A person under the influence of illegal drugs can become violent and experience super-human strength.

Sgt. Chapman agreed with the use of K9 to search for the suspect. Sgt. Chapman assigned Officers King, Bell and Mann to cover me. At approx. 1723 hrs, we approached the front door. I made several additional loud K9 announcements at the front door through the broken glass. There was no response from the suspect, but a small dog did run up to the door and officers removed the dog from the house.

I directed K9 Sig to search the house. He cleared the family room just inside the front door. Once the family room was cleared, we entered the house and made our way south to the kitchen area. I had K9 Sig search the kitchen and then directed him into the hallway off the kitchen. Myself and my cover officers maintained cover in the kitchen/family room area while K9 Sig entered the bedroom at the SW corner of the house, which had an open door. After several seconds, I heard a rustling sound in the bedroom. I moved up to the bedroom doorway with my cover officers and peeked inside to see K9 Sig engaging the suspect on the right thigh area. The suspect and K9 Sig were on top of the bed. The suspect was sitting up, gripping K9 Sig's snout with both hands, while K9 Sig had a hold of his upper leg. The suspect had one hand on the top of his snout and the other hand holding his lower jaw. The suspect was just staring at K9 Sig and not making any sounds. I immediately ordered the suspect to let go of the dog so he could release his hold. The suspect did not respond or comply. Seeing the suspect had no weapons in his hands, I approached and pulled off one of his hands while Officer Bell pulled his other arm back. I directed K9 Sig to release

his hold and we stepped back out of the room. The suspect was taken into custody by the cover officers without further incident.

Engine 6 and Medic 4, who were already on scene for the initial call, treated the suspect who was identified as William Glover. S-Glover's bite injuries included a laceration and several punctures to the right thigh, just above the knee and several minor punctures to the back of his right upper leg. At approx. 1736 hrs, I obtained a recorded statement from S-Glover at the scene. See his statement for the details. S-Glover was transported to UCDMC for additional treatment. CSI responded to the scene and UCDMC for photos. A records check showed S-Glover to have a Dangerous Drugs warrant out of Ventura Co. which was extraditable. He also had a Vandalism warrant out of Florence PD in South Carolina which was not extraditable.

I responded to UCDMC after clearing the scene. While standing in the emergency room with CSI Sgt. Lockwood, I asked S-Glover if he understood why we used a police K9 to search for him in the house. He looked at me confused and asked, "What dog?". I asked him if he knew how he got his injuries on his leg and he replied, "Those are big holes huh," while smiling.

I was advised the following day by Sgt. Carrasco that the suspect was released from custody per 849b PC due to S-Glover requiring additional treatment at the hospital.

I will seek an arrest warrant request through the Investigations Division for S-Glover on the charges of 459 PC and 148 PC.

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On 02/05/2013, at approximately 1653 hours, I (Officer King #210) was dispatched to [REDACTED] Serra Way to assist on a possible burglary suspect who just made entry in the residence. I responded code-3 (lights, and sirens), and arrived on scene at approximately 1703 hours. I observed the following in summary:

Several officers were already on scene. I responded to the front of the residence (just below the front porch) with Officer Stambaugh #565. I could see the front door (made of glass) was shattered. I observed several pieces of glass on the front porch below the door. The hole in the glass door was large enough even for a larger person to make entry. At this point the residence was surrounded by officers.

K-9 Sgt. Oliveira #3075 arrived on scene.

We stood by for several minutes. K-9 announcements were made several times from the street next to the residence (less than 30 feet away). They were loud, and clear from where I stood. I did not observe any movement, or hear any sounds in the residence.

Several more K-9 announcements were made again a few minutes later. I could hear the announcements loud, and clear.

I was part of a contact team, along with K-9 Sgt. Oliveira to search the residence. Announcements were made several more times as we entered. We made our way to a back room in the residence. He was holding the K-9's jaw, and head area. I heard Sgt. Oliveira yell several times to "let the dog go." I could not see exactly where the K-9 had a hold of Glover. Glover eventually released the dog, and was taken into custody without further incident. Glover was transported to UC Davis Medical Center. I assisted in prisoner watch until 2200 hours, when I was relieved by Officer Stambaugh.

On 02-05-13 at approx. at 1654 hours, my partner Officer J. Duckham and I, Officer J. Bell, responded to [REDACTED] Serra Wy code three from SPD Comm Center. We responded to a call for assistance regarding a possible burglary in progress call with a suspect possibly still inside the residence. We arrived on scene at approx. 1658 hours. Officer Duckham took a rear perimeter position, while I went to the front of the residence to wait for K-9 to arrived on scene.

K-9 Sgt Oliveria arrived on scene. Sgt. Chapman also arrived on scene and designated me as a contact team Officer with Officer King and Officer Mann. When I entered the room I could see that there was a subject lying on the bed and the K-9 dog had his mouth around one of the subjects legs. I could see that the subject was holding onto the dogs mouth with both hands. Sgt. Oliveria ordered the subject multiple times to release the dog and the subject would not let go. I eventually had to grab the subjects right hand and pry it off of the dogs mouth. I placed the subjects right hand in a rear twist lock and was able to get a handcuff on his wrist. Officer King and Mann were able to work the subjects left wrist behind his back and I placed the other cuff on that arm. I double locked the handcuffs.

Medical personnel were called in to treat the subjects injuries which resulted from the dog bite.

On 2-5-13 at approx. 1736 hrs, I, Sgt. Oliveira, read suspect William Glover his Miranda rights per SPD Miranda card at [REDACTED] Serra Wy. S-Glover was sitting on the bed inside the house and had already been treated by SFD medics. After each right I read, I asked if he understood. He stated, "yeah" or "yes", each time. I asked S-Glover if he would tell me what he was doing in this house. See the ICC recording (Veh#10477) for the entire interview. S-Glover appeared to have a difficult time focusing and answering my questions. He stated the following in summary:

I was trying to be calm and not drink liquor. I hit the door with my elbow. I leaned into to the door and broke the glass. I didn't mean to come in. I wanted to come in to sleep. I wasn't going to steal anything.

I just leaned into the door to go to sleep. I didn't hear the K9 announcements on the speaker. I didn't hear the K9 announcements at the door.

I was on the bed when the dog found me. I had fallen asleep. The dog got me.

(I, Sgt. Oliveira, asked S-Glover why he didn't let go of the dog when I

told him to and he replied that he did. I reminded him that we had to pull his hands off the dog. He stated that his hands were cuffed behind him. I told him that he was handcuffed now but wasn't before. I asked him why he didn't say or yell anything when the dog got him. He stated the following in summary:)

I didn't know what to do. It hurt.

I understand breaking into someone's house is wrong. I didn't mean to break in. I haven't used any drugs or been drinking alcohol. I've never been in this house before.

(I, Sgt. Oliveira, asked him what happened before he came into this house when he was laying down in someone's driveway. He didn't answer the question.)
