# **Incident Summary**

On 7-7-16, at approx. 1318 hours, Officer B. Jensen and J. Jennings were working a two man car and were in full uniformed and marked vehicle. They were flagged down by a Regional Transient security guard whom stated a known subject was high on methamphetamine and acting strange. The officers saw subject Charles Reed dancing in the street on the light rail tracks. Officer Jensen noted that the subject was taking a fighting stance in the street and looked like he was threatening passersbys.

The subject walked to the sidewalk as officers drove towards him and walked towards him. The subject yelled "fuck this nigger and fuck all these niggers out here." The subject initially complied and sat on the sidewalk. Officers noticed the subject had an odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from him and combined with his actions concluded he was so drunk he could not care for himself.

Officer P. Diaz and Officer D. Walker arrived on scene to assist and the subject continued to verbally abusive and officers grabbed a hold of him to place him in cuffs and he began to attempt to pull away. Officer Jennings was putting the subjects left arm in a twist lock, Officer Jensen and Walker were controlling the subjects right arm and Officer Diaz began to pull the subject to the ground; in addition Officer Jennings swept the subjects legs. The other subject went to the ground an hit his forehead on a planter just to his right. The area above his head began to bleed and he sustained a 2" laceration. Officers requested code three medical and had to continue to hold the subject on the ground because he was attempting to get up. He was continuing to be verbally abusive. A spit mask was placed on the subject.

This incident was captured on R.T. surveillance. I reviewed the surveillance and saw that the subject was extremely agitated and appeared like he wanted to fist fight officers as he shifted his weight from foot to foot like a boxer. In addition, witness statements stated the subject was acting hostile, looked like he was on methamphetamine, yelling "nigger," trying to cause fights and that he appeared to want to fight the officers.

The subject had to be transported to the hospital for stitches/staples. Due to an extended ETA to have him medically cleared he was cited for 148 PC. I concluded this use of force was within policy based on the totality of the circumstances. The RT video of the incident was booked as evidence. Officers Jennings and Jensen did activate their ICC cameras after the subject was taken down. Officers Diaz and Walker activated their ICC camera before they contacted the subject.

I reviewed the ICC policy with Officers Jennings and Jensen, reminding them their ICC needed to be activated prior to contacting the subject.

On 07-07-2016, we (Ofc. Jensen #424 and Ofc. Jennings #269) were on routine patrol in the downtown area of Sacramento. We were both wearing full SPD uniforms and driving in a marked SPD patrol car. At approx. 1312 hrs, we were clearing a call at 12th St/F St. We were hailed by a light rail security officer at the Alkali Flats Light Rail station. The security officer pointed out a WMA (Later identified as Reed, Charles) who was standing in the middle of the street near 12th St/E St. S-Reed was dancing in the middle of the light rail tracks without a shirt on and looked like he was taking a fighting stance and threatening people who were at the light rail station.

We drove across the street (E/S of 12th St) to 415 12th St. As we approached S-Reed, he immediately became aggressive towards officers. Ofc. Jennings attempted to make contact with S-Reed. Reed started yelling "Fuck this Nigger and fuck all these Niggers out here."

Ofc. Jennings got S-Reed up on to the sidewalk and got him to sit down. I was standing approx. 3' away (downwind) and could smell the odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from Reed. I overheard Reed state "You ain't gonna touch me. You Niggers are not gonna touch me."

S-Reed was using inflammatory language towards the individuals standing around the light rail station. Most of the persons at the light rail were African American. S-Reed (who is white) was constantly using the word "Nigger" when he was talking to people.

S-Reed was saying "You ain't gonna touch me. You ain't gonna touch me."

S-Reed started to stand up and tried to walk away. While he was starting to walk away, he was very verbally abusive to the people at the light rail station.

Ofc. Diaz and Ofc. (1B31) arrived on scene to assist.

Both officer Jennings and myself were worried for S-Reeds welfare not only based on his level of intoxication, but the verbiage he was using in a predominately black area.

We decided to book S-Reed for 647(f) P.C.-drunk in public.

Ofc. Jennings started to reach out and gain a wrist lock control hold on S-Reed. 1B31 also stepped in to assist. S-Reed immediately tensed up and made his arms extremely rigid. When he first stood up, S-Reed had picked up his backpack. I was concerned that he would injure an officer with the backpack, so I removed the backpack from his right hand. Officers were not able to gain control of Reed while we were standing there. I heard Ofc. Diaz say "Take him to the ground." I was standing off to Reeds left side. Ofc. Walker and Ofc. Jennings both had control of an arm. officers attempted to place Reed on the ground and onto his stomach. In this position, it is much easier for officers to handcuff him. As Reed started to go down, he fell forward. Before officers could catch him, Reed hit his head on a metal planter box. None of the officers on scene had seen the planter box prior to Reed making contact with it. I observed blood from the right side of S-Reeds head. I immediately started Sac Fire Dept code-3. I also requested 2SM3 to respond.

Officers maintained control of S-Reed while he was on the ground. Reed never lost consciousness and continued to verbally berate officers and pedestrians as they we near the light rail. SFD finally arrived and treated Reed for a head laceration. Reed was restrained to the gunnery by fire and the PD. SFD Medic20 transported Reed to Mercy General Hosp. Ofc Jennings rode with reed in the rear of the ambulance.

Once on scene at the hospital, Reed continued to be physically and verbally abusive. Reed attempted to spit on medical personnel and almost bit another. Hosp staff had to give Reed a powerful sedative before they could treat his injuries. Reeds injuries consisted on an approx. 2" head laceration that required 12 staples to close. Based on the amount of time that Reed would be at the Hospital (six to eight hours minimum), 3SM3 (Sgt. Farnsowrth) told us to give S-Reed a citation for 148(A)(1) P.C.-resist arrest or obstruct.

S-Reed was cited and released per 853.6 P.C. and given a court date. Reeds copy of the citation was placed in his personal property at the Hospital.

Based on S-Reeds abusive behavior and level of awareness due to the medication given by the hosp staff, officers were unable to get a mirandized statement from Reed.

On this date, we (2B33) took no further action in this case.

On 07/07/2016, at approximately 1314, Officer Diaz #640 and I (Officer Walker #835) arrived at 415 12th St to assist other SPD Officers with a violent 5150 subject. The following are my observations in summary:

Officers Jennings #269 and Jensen #424, were already on scene when we arrived. They advised that they had a violent mental health or drunk subject who was refusing to comply with their commands and who had verbally told the officers they will not touch him.

When we arrived, I found both Officer Jennings and Jensen talking to a MWA. The MWA was later identified by Officer Jennings and Jensen as S-Charles Reed. I could see that S-Reed was acting very belligerent and was not complying with Officers commands. S-Reed had shifted his feet into a more aggressive stance, with his right foot offset from his left foot.

I could see S-Reed was moving to his right, my left, and getting ready to walk away from officers. He was placing his right arm though the right right strap of his backpack and getting ready to walk away. Officer Jensen immediately grabbed ahold of S-Reeds left arm and I grabbed ahold of S-Reeds right arm. As I had ahold of S-Reeds arm, I could feel that he had balled up his right hand into a fist. I could also feel that S-Reed had

tensed up the muscles in his right arm.

I felt that by tensing up his muscles, S-Reed was getting ready to fight with us as we had ahold of his arms. I told S-Reed not to tense up his arms and told him not to ball his fists up. S-Reed kept his right arm tense and did not follow my commands. I attempted to place S-Reeds arm into a rear wrist lock to handcuff him, but he kept his right arm tense and actively resisted my attempt to control his arm.

Officer Jensen, Diaz and I took S-Reed to the ground to gain a better handcuffing position. S-Reed physically resisted the entire time. Just before S-Reed was completely on the ground, S-Reed's head struck a metal flower pot, which cut his head. He began to bleed profusely from that cut.

We immediately gained control of S-Reed when he was on the ground and handcuffed him. Medical attention was requested for S-Reed's wounds.

2SM3, Sgt. Harbison, arrived on scene and conducted a canvas of the area for witnesses. See his observations for further details.

S-Reed was transported by SFD Medics to Mercy General. See Officer Jensen's observations for further information.

Officer Diaz took possession of S-Reeds backpack and secured it in the back seat of our patrol vehicle. We later booked S-Reeds personal property for safe keeping at 555 Sequoia Pacific (Property) for safe keeping.
