



I explained that since she was only here for a week, she had not established residency and we would assist them in getting her to leave.

We entered the house where Elise was kneeling on the floor in the living room.

I told Elise she needed to grab her things and leave. She started talking about how her parents didn't care about her. I explained that we were not going to discuss that and she needed to leave. She then started in about how she has no place to go and where was she supposed to go. I explained that she was an adult and she would need to figure it out.

She started screaming about how she already had it figured out but no one was helping her.

I then explained that we had told her twice that she needed to get up and walk out the door and if she did not comply we would escort her out. I explained that we did not want to hurt her and I asked her to simply walk out on her own like an adult.

I asked her what she would do if I did let her go and said she would get her things.

I asked her where her things were and she screamed "I don't know!"

I told Officer Brandt, let's just walk her outside and we will get her things for her.

We started to walk her out onto the porch and Elise started pulling her arms and flailing her body around.

I attempted to get a better hold on her left arm and she bent forward at the waist and put her head down almost onto a chair that was sitting on the porch.

I started to apply a rear wrist lock on her left arm and I could see Officer Brandt doing something similar on her right arm.

As I started to apply some pressure, I heard a loud pop and felt something in her elbow area.

I realized she was injured and I held her arm still to try and prevent further injury.

At first, she did not react and I told her not to move her arm because her arm was hurt.



I asked Jacobson-Salazar what she had in the house and she advised a few boxes. I asked her to begin gathering her items because she had to leave. Jacobson-Salazar shook her head no and continued looking at her phone. I again asked her to get her things together and she said no.

Both Ofc. Vito and I asked Jacobson-Salazar multiple times to grab her belongings and leave the house but she refused. Because Jacobson-Salazar had no standing in the residence and refused to leave Ofc. Vito and I escorted Jacobson-Salazar out of the house.

Ofc. Vito and each grabbed one of Jacobson-Salazar's arms and began walking her to the front door. I let go of her right arm because there was not enough space for all of us to walk around the dining room table. When Ofc. Vito and Jacobson-Salazar got to the front door she became irate and was yelling. Jacobson-Salazar grabbed onto the frame of the door and refused to go further.

I grabbed onto Jacobson-Salazar right arm by her wrist and held onto it. While holding onto her arm, Jacobson-Salazar continued yelling was attempting to wave her arm around and pull free. Ofc. Vito and I escorted Jacobson-Salazar out onto the front porch. Once on the porch,

Ofc. Vito grabbed onto Jacobson-Salazar left arm and also placed her in a control hold. Jacobson-Salazar continued moving around and trying to push her body up. During this time, Ofc. Vito continued telling Jacobson-Salazar to stop multiple times. While holding onto her and trying to maintain control of her, I heard a "pop" noise come from Jacobson-Salazar left arm.
