Incident Summary

On 02/03/21 at approx. 1220 hours dispatch received a call about a subject who was in his underwear exposing his penis. The complainant advised that the subject was holding a stick in his hand and was in the street. Officers arrived on scene and contacted the subject (Later Identified as ██████████). After attempting to De-Escalate with ██████████ for approx. 19 minutes and 44 seconds ██████████ refused to put the stick down that he possessed. A contact team was formed to detain ██████████. As Officers walked closer to ██████████ ██████████ remained aggressive and took a fighting stance with Officers. Officer Schneider deployed her CED towards ██████████. Officer Schneider's CED deployment may or may not have been effective. Officer Walker then deployed his CED toward ██████████ which was effective ██████████ fell forward causing his face to strike the asphalt ██████████ was taken into custody and later transported to UC Davis Medical Center for injuries he sustained.

- Two officers were involved in the application of force (Officer Schneider & Officer Walker). The incident was captured on their respective body worn cameras.

On 02-03-2021, at approx 1259 hours, Ofc D. Walker# 835 and I (Ofc Madsen# 421) responded to assist officers with a mental subject (subject later identified as [REDACTED]) that was standing in the street, in his underwear at Wilkinson St/37th Ave. [REDACTED] was holding a small stick and pulling his penis out. We were in full police uniforms and driving a fully mark SPD patrol vehicle. Upon our arrival on scene, we blocked N/B traffic with our patrol unit. Our body worn camera was activated and recording the entire call.

As we arrived on scene, Cpl Mabunga was attempting to establish a rapport with [REDACTED] as other officers on scene were standing by with less-lethal shotguns and tasers. [REDACTED] remained defiant and took a fighting stance and waved the stick around on several instances. Ofc Rappazzo took over dialogue for Cpl Mabunga, however she was not able to make him comply either. Officers attempted to de-escalate [REDACTED] for approx 10 - 15 minutes, with no avail.

[REDACTED] peered south on several occasions, as if he was looking for a place to run. It was my fear that [REDACTED] would run down the block and possibly hurt a member of the public.

It was at approx this time, that Sgt D. Smith gave the order for officers to close in and for Cpl Schneider and Ofc D. Walker to deploy their CED's should they get an opportunity. Once officers were approx 15 feet from [REDACTED], he continued to wave the stick around and remained in his fighting stance. Cpl Schneider deployed her CED, with very little to no effect. Immediately there after, Ofc Walker deployed his CED, completely incapacitating [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] froze/locked-up, and then fell face first onto the pavement. Officers then placed hand cuffs onto [REDACTED] without incident. Medics then responded and treated [REDACTED]'s injuries. [REDACTED] was transported to UC Davis Med Center, for 5150 evaluation and further treatment of his injuries.

We stopped our vehicle approx 20 yds North of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was standing on the west edge of the intersection and appeared agitated. Ofc. Mabunga stopped our patrol vehicle and attempted to deescalate the situation by engaging [REDACTED] in verbal dialog. I stepped out of the vehicle and deployed the less lethal bean bag shot gun. Ofc. Mabunga gave numerous directions to [REDACTED] to drop the stick and comply with our orders. Ofc. Mabunga informed dispatch that we had an un-cooperative subject with a stick. After approx 5 min of negotiating with [REDACTED] Ofc. Walker #835, Ofc. Madsen #421, Ofc. Schneider #490, Ofc. Gutierrez #701, Ofc. Lenehan #929 and Sgt. Smith #3123 arrived on scene to assist.

Ofc. Mabunga attempted to continue to deescalate the situation requesting for [REDACTED] to drop the stick numerous times. [REDACTED] did not comply with our directions to drop the stick and continued being agitated often looking around and waiving the stick. Officers voiced that [REDACTED] was on formal searchable probation and had a history of fighting. [REDACTED] has also been placed on multiple 5150 holds and has a history of aggressive behavior (see supplement by Officer Walker #835 for details regarding [REDACTED]'s history).

Fearing for my safety, as well as the safety of other officers and citizens, I deployed my Taser 7 as a less lethal option. Other Officers had less lethal shotguns and a 40 mm impact launcher.

Officer Mabunga spent several minutes talking to [REDACTED] and attempting to negotiate for a peaceful contact, including having [REDACTED] drop the stick he was holding. The attempts at peaceful negotiation were unsuccessful. [REDACTED] was not responding to officers commands.

2SM6 (Sgt. D. Smith) arrived on scene. Sgt. Smith arranged officers into an arrest team. I was assigned to continue with my Taser 7 as a less lethal option. Sgt. Smith told the arrest team to get closer to [REDACTED] and approach him. If [REDACTED] did not drop the stick and continued to be aggressive, I was to discharge my Taser 7 to take [REDACTED] into custody without further incident.

As the arrest team began to get closer to [REDACTED] (moved from about 30 feet away to approx. 15 feet away), negotiations continued to fail. [REDACTED] became more aggressive as officers approached. He started slashing his stick in the air, directed towards officers, in a more aggressive manner. He also took a fighting stance.

Based on his history and behavior, I observed this to be an indicator that [REDACTED] would continue to be assaultive or resistive with officers.

[REDACTED] had demonstrated by his words and actions that he had an intention to be violent or physically resist, and reasonably appeared to have the potential to harm officers, himself, or another person.

I had my CED lasers pointed directly at him as I gave [REDACTED] commands to stop moving and drop the stick. I advised [REDACTED] I would use my Taser as a less lethal option, that he would get Tased if he did not drop the stick, and that

he would get Tased if he continued acting aggressive. [REDACTED] was given at least five commands by me directly that he would get Tased if he did not comply.

Other officers also gave commands. [REDACTED] did not comply with commands.

With [REDACTED] approx. 10 feet away, I gave a "Taser Taser Taser" command and, fearing for my safety and the safety of my fellow officers, I discharged my CED at [REDACTED] for one full (5 second) cycle. It appeared the Taser 7 was not effective (later determined only one probe hit).

Officer Walker discharged his Taser 7.

The CED was effective and [REDACTED] immediately tensed his body and fell forward to the ground. Based on my training and experience, subjects who are incapacitated with a CED can immediately recover when the cycle is over. I immediately gave officers commands for handcuffing to prevent another discharge of the CED.

[REDACTED] was handcuffed without further incident. The fire department was requested Code 3 for medical aid. [REDACTED] was awake, alert, and talking. He was monitored for cognitive function and breathing. [REDACTED] was put in a position of recovery. The right side of his face hit the ground when [REDACTED] was incapacitated by the Taser 7. His face and mouth were bleeding.

SFD Engine #10 and Medic #10 responded for medical aid. (See Officer Walker/Mabunga supplements for further).

I recognized V- [REDACTED] from a call for service where he had barricaded himself in his mother's garage and had burned pieces of her personal property in the front driveway and roadway. V- [REDACTED] was later placed on the above probation status for the incident, SPD #20-252549.

An automated records check also indicated V- [REDACTED] had been placed on multiple 5150 holds as a danger to himself and others over the past two years, SPD #19-222119, #19-266453, and #20-68665. V- [REDACTED] had also been arrested for 148 PC on 02/16/2020, SPD #20-52372.

We arrived on scene at approximately 1259 hours. Officers Mabunga #300, Chitwood #625, Zeek #417, Lenehan #929, Rappazzo #669, Schneider #490, B. Gutierrez #701, and Sgt D. Smith #3123 were already on scene.

I observed V- [REDACTED] wearing only his underwear and swinging a wooden stick around in the intersection. The stick was approximately 2 feet long and approximately 1/4" - 1/2" in diameter.

Officers had southbound Wilkinson St at 37th Ave and westbound 37th Ave at Wilkinson blocked off to prevent V- [REDACTED] from walking toward members of the public who were out walking around or in their front yards.

Officers were attempting to make verbal contact with V- [REDACTED]. V- [REDACTED] was not responding to their attempts to make verbal contact or conversation. V- [REDACTED] would not even look or acknowledge the officers who were attempting to contact him.

Officer Madsen and I used our patrol vehicle to block northbound traffic at 38th Ave and Wilkinson St. Officer Madsen and I maintained the southern perimeter spot to prevent V- [REDACTED] from running away from officers and possibly harming citizens who were walking up and down the street.

Officers attempted for approximately 15-20 minutes to de-escalate the situation without any success. During this time V- [REDACTED] became more agitated. He faced the officers, took a bladed fighting stance, and started swinging the stick around. It appeared that V- [REDACTED] was preparing to fight the officers who were attempting to de-escalate the situation.

Sgt Smith assembled officers into a contact team in order to close the distance with V- [REDACTED] and make better contact with him since our attempts at de-escalating the situation from a distance was not working.

As officers approached V- [REDACTED] he began to back up and away from the contact team. Officer Madsen and I blocked V- [REDACTED] from fleeing south on Wilkinson St. We then made contact with V- [REDACTED] in front of [REDACTED] Wilkinson St. V- [REDACTED] again took a bladed fighting stance, similar to a boxer, and was waving the stick in his hand at officers.

During this time other officers, including Officer Schneider, were giving V- [REDACTED] verbal commands to comply and advising him he may be tased if he did not comply. I did not give him any verbal commands or warnings because I did not want to confuse V- [REDACTED] by having multiple officers give him commands at once.

Sgt Smith gave officers the command to deploy a Taser if he remained a threat to flee or fight with officers.

Officer Schneider deployed her Taser one time. I could see one probe strike V- [REDACTED] in the upper torso, but it did not appear to be effective. V- [REDACTED] was still approaching officers with the stick in his hand.

I then deployed my Taser 7 for one cycle, approximately 5 seconds, based on the following:

- V- [REDACTED] had become more aggressive as officers approached to de-escalate the situation.
- V- [REDACTED] was still swinging the stick around and in the direction of officers.
- V- [REDACTED] was began to approach and lunge at officers with the stick.
- I was afraid for the safety of other officers and the public if V- [REDACTED] was to strike them with the stick.

- I was afraid if V- [REDACTED] struck an officer with the stick it could cause great bodily injury

- I was also afraid V- [REDACTED] may flee from officers and run towards members of the public who were walking in the area and cause them harm or towards his mother's address ([REDACTED]) where he has a valid RO preventing him from going within 100 yards of his mother and her address, RO [REDACTED], FCN [REDACTED]. His mother's address was only one block away from this incident.

I observed one probe from my Taser 7 strike V- [REDACTED] on his rear right upper shoulder. I observed the second probe strike V- [REDACTED] in his left knee. The second taser deployment was immediately effective and caused complete neuromuscular incapacitation to V- [REDACTED]. As V- [REDACTED] was incapacitated from the taser he fell face first onto the roadway and appeared to strike the right side of his head one time on the asphalt. V- [REDACTED] then began to bleed from the right side of his face.

While V- [REDACTED] was incapacitated, other officers approached V- [REDACTED] and detained him in handcuffs. Officer Schneider and I both removed our Taser 7 cartridges and tossed them on the ground so officers would not be entangled in the taser wire. While the cartridges were on the ground they became mixed up. I was unable to determine which taser cartridge was mine or Officer Schneider's.

While officers were handcuffing V- [REDACTED] I observed two separate probes were loose and on the ground. Both probes were around his legs. One probe had blood on it. I secured both loose probes in a used Taser 7 cartridge container to prevent officers from being injured by the probes.

I later gathered both Taser 7 close quarter cartridges and took possession of them.

Medical attention was immediately requested "Code-3" for V- [REDACTED] injuries and taser deployment. Medic 10 arrived on scene and transported V- [REDACTED] to UC Davis Medical. I rode with Medic 10 to UC Davis Medical Center. While at UC Davis Medical Center doctors removed the two taser probes from V- [REDACTED] front torso and rear right upper shoulder. I collected the taser probes and placed them in a used taser cartridge.

I conduct threat assessments and pursue additional resources and/or other legal options available to stabilize the situation. The MHU works closely with other units in the department to identify potential individuals requiring mental health related interventions. Our primary objectives are to enhance public safety by evaluating and mitigating the level of risk those individuals pose to themselves and others.

I was working with the Mental Health Unit and was assigned follow-up on this case on Friday, 2/5/21. Ofc Hughes #718 and I responded to UC Davis Medical Center on Thursday afternoon (2/4/21) and contacted [REDACTED] in the emergency room. It was confirmed by clinician staff in the Crisis Unit that the 5150 WI hold that officers completed prior was upheld and [REDACTED] was awaiting placement to an extended mental healthcare facility. On 2/3/2021, at approx. 1304 hrs, while in full SPD uniform/marked police vehicle, I arrived to the intersection of 37th Ave/Wilkinson St. regarding a subject armed with a stick and exposing his penis to citizens. I was wearing my body worn camera (BWC) which was activated and recorded the incident. Upon arrival, I observed a male subject (later identified as [REDACTED]) only wearing white brief underwear and he was holding an approx. 2' long, 1" diameter stick. Officers Mabunga, Chitwood, Zeek, Lenehan, Rappazzo, Schneider, Madsen, Walker, and Gutierrez were already onscene and had blocked off the intersection to minimize vehicle traffic and contain [REDACTED]. Officer Mabunga was in communication with [REDACTED] while other officers maintained a safe distance from [REDACTED] and had less lethal weapons deployed if needed.

On the southeast corner of 37th Ave/Wilkinson St. were three males who knew [REDACTED] and were also trying to get him to put the stick down. One male (unknown identity) advised that [REDACTED] was under the influence of some "bad meth" and he knows [REDACTED] will not put the stick down. Another male (unknown identity) offered to go get the stick from [REDACTED] and at one point, asked if he could use our taser to get [REDACTED] to put the stick down.

While attempting to gain communication with [REDACTED], Officer Lenehan located [REDACTED] clothes and laid them out in front of him to see if he would get dressed. After gaining no compliance with [REDACTED], Officer Rappazzo

As we progressed towards [REDACTED], he began swinging the stick around like a baton and took an aggressive, fighting stance. Once the arrest team was in position, Officer Schnieder deployed her taser towards [REDACTED].

One probe struck [REDACTED] in his upper right chest and the other probe missed. Officer Walker then deployed his taser towards [REDACTED]. One probe struck [REDACTED] in his right, rear shoulder blade and the other struck his left knee. [REDACTED] quickly dropped the stick and fell forward to the ground (concrete roadway). The assigned arrest team were able to detain [REDACTED] without further incident. We requested medical aid for [REDACTED] as it appeared he lost a few teeth as a result of the fall. Engine 10/Medic 10 arrived onscene and provided medical aid to [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was transported to UCDMC for treatment.

Officers onscene then conducted a neighborhood canvas and made contact with citizens who witnessed the incident. The two males who I spoke to as I arrived on scene refused to provide their names/personal information. CSI was requested for follow up and a red border form was completed.
