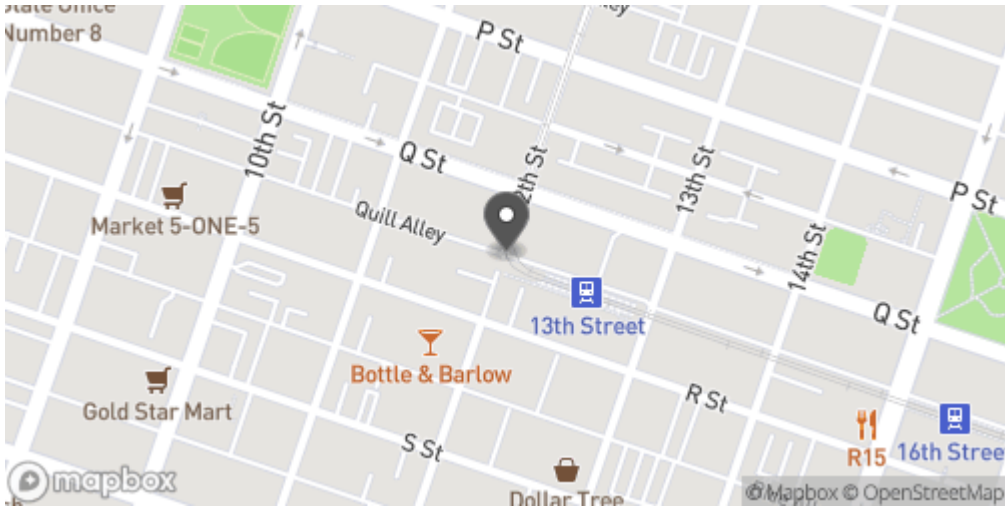

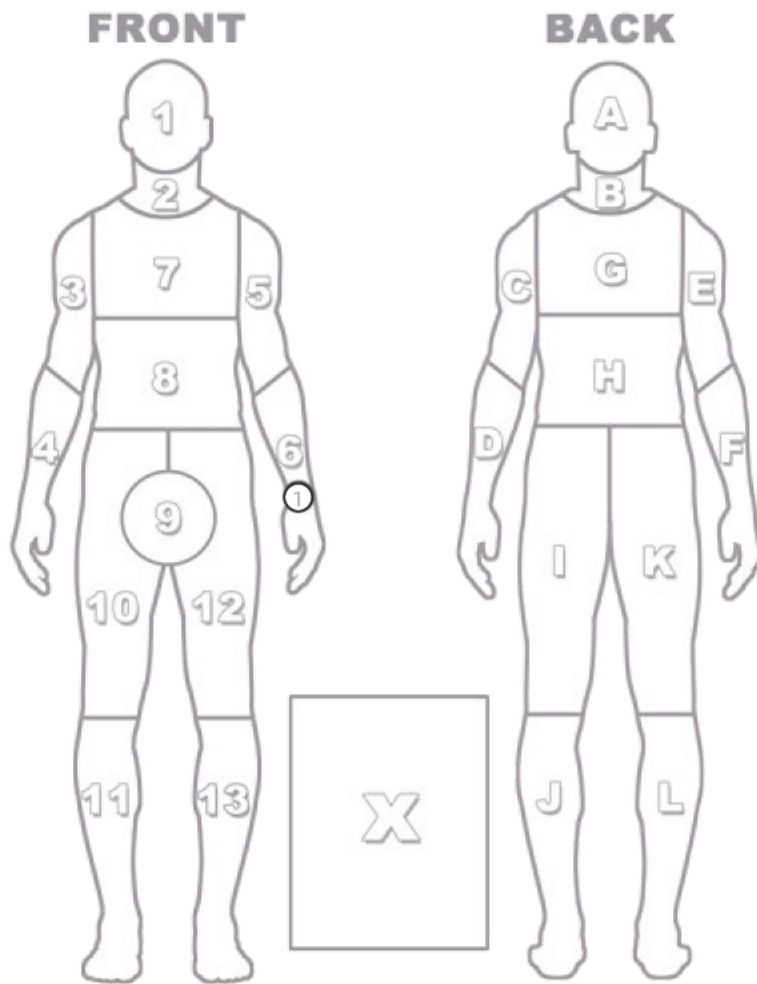

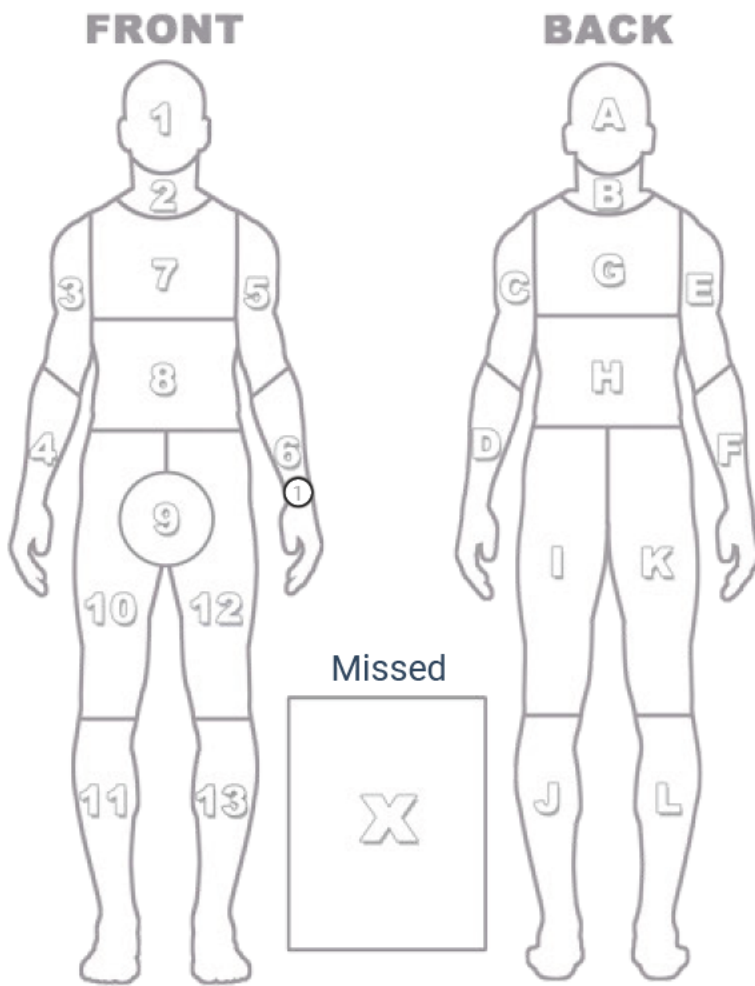

**Incident Summary:**

On February 22, 2023, at approximately 2157 hours, Sacramento Police Officer Anthony Nunez #512 was assigned to Regional Transit Police Services and working as RT32.

At approximately 2157 hours, Rail 31, later identified as Adam Ellis (Regional Transit Supervisor) and an additional Regional Transit employee Igor Tatarenko, were on scene at the 13<sup>th</sup> Street Light Rail Station (LRS) with a female subject (later identified as ██████████) who was refusing to leave the inbound train ramp and advised that she needed medical aid, Per Ellis' statement, he believed that Hopkins may have been experiencing homelessness.

Ellis requested a medical response via his radio at the request of ██████████. Sacramento Fire Department (SFD) responded to the scene.

At approximately 2215 hours, Officer Nunez responded to the 13<sup>th</sup> St LRS to assist Ellis and Tatarenko. Per Officer Nunez' report, he contacted the fire personnel on scene and was advised that ██████████ did not have a "chief complaint of pain" and just wanted a ride to Carmichael. As a result, SFD cleared the scene. Based on my review of the incident, I was unable to confirm if fire obtained a signed medical release from ██████████.

According to Officer Nunez' BWC, he told ██████████ three (3) different times that she needed to leave RT property. ██████████ advised that she was in possession of an "all day pass" which she attempted to locate. ██████████ was again asked to leave RT property after not being able to provide proof of possessing a valid fare. ██████████ refused. Per Officer Nunez' report, ██████████ was trespassing on RT property since she did not have a valid fare and was told to leave multiple times.

Per Officer Nunez' BWC and observations, he placed [REDACTED] right arm in a control hold and attempted to escort her off the RT ramp. Per BWC, [REDACTED] began flailing around at which time Officer Nunez released control of [REDACTED] and gave her the opportunity to collect her belongings, on her own, and leave the station.

[REDACTED] remained on the RT ramp and began yelling and crying while still refusing to leave.

Per Ofc. Nunez' BWC, Officer Nunez grabbed [REDACTED] left arm and placed it into a two-handed rear wrist lock and began escorting her down the ramp.

Per Ofc. Nunez' BWC, while he was escorting [REDACTED] down the ramp, [REDACTED] moved her body into a railing on the left side of the ramp at which time Officer Nunez released the rear handed wrist lock and grabbed [REDACTED] left bicep with both hands. [REDACTED] started flailing around and dropped to the ground. Ofc. Nunez did not have physical contact with [REDACTED] while she was on the ground.

Per BWC, Officer Nunez assisted [REDACTED] up by holding onto her left bicep. Just as [REDACTED] got into a standing position, she dropped to the ground again.

Once [REDACTED] was on the ground Officer Nunez released [REDACTED] arm. Per BWC, while [REDACTED] was on the ground she yelled, "you broke my arm". [REDACTED] continued to move around on the ground making quick and jerky movements. Additionally, she continued to make comments about her wrist being broken.

Officer Nunez helped [REDACTED] to her feet. Per Officer Nunez' report, he "did not observe any obvious injury" to [REDACTED] arm or wrist.

Per BWC, Officer Nunez offered to drive [REDACTED] to the hospital because of the verbal complaints she was making about her wrist being broken. Officer Nunez also offered to have SFD respond back out to their location to look at her wrist. [REDACTED] refused transportation to the hospital or to have the SFD respond back out. Instead, [REDACTED] advised she wanted to take the train to the Sunrise LRS.

Per BWC, a Sunrise bound LR train arrived on scene and Officer Nunez assisted [REDACTED] onto the train.

Later, at approximately 2359 hours, SPD Regional Transit Police Officer Jaguar Hepler #932 (RT31) and Officer Nunez responded to the Watt Ave/Manlove LRS regarding [REDACTED], who was again requesting medical aid on the train.

Per Officer Nunez' report, he observed "minor" swelling to [REDACTED] left wrist. Again, [REDACTED] refused medical aid.

Per BWC, [REDACTED] exited the train and requested a ride to the hospital for boils that were covering her body because of a STD.

Officer Hepler voluntarily transported [REDACTED] to Mercy San Juan Medical Center at her request. Officer Nunez responded, as well.

Upon their arrival, per Officer Hepler's BWC, Officer Hepler dropped [REDACTED] off near the entrance to the hospital.

Per Officer Nunez' BWC and the report, Officer Nunez contacted Sgt. Buchanan, via phone, and provided him with an update surrounding the circumstances of the call.

Per Officer Nunez' BWC, the decision was made to have CSI respond to the hospital and photograph [REDACTED] injured wrist, if she was willing to have photos taken. [REDACTED] advised officers that she would allow photographs to be taken of her wrist, but only after photos were taken by the hospital.

Per the report, Forensic Investigator Garcia #6368 arrived on scene to take photographs of [REDACTED].

According to Officer Hepler's BWC, both he and Officer Nunez told [REDACTED] no fewer than five (5) times they wanted CSI to take photos of her left arm. [REDACTED] advised adamantly, multiple times, that she did not want CSI to take photos of her arm.

Per Officer Hepler's BWC, Officer Hepler grabbed onto [REDACTED] right arm while Officer Nunez grabbed onto [REDACTED] left arm. [REDACTED] repeatedly told officers to let go of her while she was physically uncooperative and trying to break free from their grasp. While officers continued to struggle with [REDACTED], FI Garcia was able to take three (3) photographs of [REDACTED].

Per Officer Nunez' observations, they (the officers) were attempting "to hold [REDACTED] in a way that CSI could document the arm with photos".

It should be noted that [REDACTED] was not in police custody at this time, was not being placed on a 5150 hold, and was not detained.

Once photos had been taken, [REDACTED] began undressing and proceeded to lock herself in the lobby bathroom of the emergency room. Eventually, hospital staff admitted [REDACTED] and Officers Nunez and Hepler cleared the scene.

On 02/23/23, at approximately 1017 hours, SPD RT Detective Dustin Southward #690 responded to Mercy San Juan Medical Center to obtain an update on the condition of [REDACTED] injuries. Per Detective Southward's report, the treating physician advised Detective Southward that [REDACTED] appeared to have preexisting fracture to her left wrist that had been re-fractured.

**Summary:**

On 2/23/23, at approximately 1048 hours, the Force Investigations Team was notified of a FIT call out related to an incident that began the evening prior, on 2/22/23 at 2215 hours. FIT responded to the SPD Joseph E. Rooney Police Facility, where were briefed by Sergeant Ryan Buchanan #3036. FIT was provided with the following information.

On 02/22/23, at approximately 2215 hours, SPD Officer Anthony Nunez #512 was assigned to Regional Transit Police Services as RT32. Officer Nunez responded to the 13th St Light Rail Station (LRS) regarding an RT rail unit who was with a female subject (identified as [REDACTED]) who was requesting the Sacramento Fire Department (SFD). [REDACTED] was experiencing homelessness at the time of this incident. [REDACTED] denied medical care when SFD arrived on scene and was requested by the RT rail unit to be removed from RT property.

SFD personnel told Officer Nunez that [REDACTED] did not have a chief complaint of pain, but wanted a ride to Carmichael. SFD cleared the scene and [REDACTED] was asked to leave RT property. [REDACTED] advised she had an all-day pass, which she could not locate. [REDACTED] was again asked to leave RT property because she did not have valid fare.

Officer Nunez placed [REDACTED] right arm in a control hold in an attempt to escort her off of the RT ramp. [REDACTED] began flailing around at which time Officer Nunez released the control hold and gave her an opportunity to leave the station.

[REDACTED] refused to leave, at which time Officer Nunez placed [REDACTED] left arm in a two-handed rear wrist lock. While walking down the RT ramp, [REDACTED] threw herself to the ground and continued screaming. While laying on the ground, [REDACTED] complained of her arm and wrist being broken. Officer Nunez helped [REDACTED] off the ground and she began to thrash around and continued to yell. Officer Nunez did not observe any obvious injuries to [REDACTED] arm or wrist.

Officer Nunez offered medical aid to [REDACTED] numerous times throughout the contact and also offered to drive [REDACTED] to the hospital. [REDACTED] refused transportation and wanted to get on the train to the Sunrise LRS. Officer Nunez did not observe any visible injuries on [REDACTED] wrist or arm. Officer Nunez assisted [REDACTED] onto an RT train bound for the Sunrise LRS. SPD Regional Transit Sergeant Buchanan (RT30) was advised of the call.

At approximately 2359 hours, Officer Hepler (RT31) and Officer Nunez responded to the Watt Ave/Manlove LRS regarding [REDACTED], who was again requesting medical on the train. At this time, Officer Nunez observed that [REDACTED] had swelling to her left wrist, but did not want fire to treat her. Officers Hepler and Nunez offered medical treatment numerous times, which were denied by [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] requested that Officers transport her to the hospital.

Officers Nunez and Helper transported [REDACTED] to Mercy San Juan Medical Center. Sergeant Buchanan was advised of the updates regarding [REDACTED]. SPD CSI responded to Mercy San Juan Hospital and photographed [REDACTED] injuries.

Officers cleared the call once [REDACTED] was checked into the emergency room and no further assistance

was needed.

On 2/23/23, at approximately 1017 hours, SPD RT Detective Southward responded to Mercy San Juan Medical Center to receive an update on the condition of [REDACTED] injuries. The treating physician advised that [REDACTED] appeared to have an old break injury to her left wrist that was re-fractured.

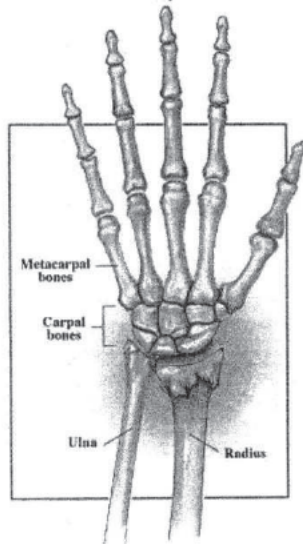

Your caregiver has diagnosed you as having a fracture of the wrist. A *fracture* is a break in the bone or bones. A cast or splint is used to protect and keep your injured bone(s) from moving. The cast or splint will usually be on for about 5 to 6 weeks. One of the bones of the wrist (the *navicular* bone) often does not show up as a fracture on x-ray until later or in the healing phase. With this bone your caregiver will often cast as though it is fractured even if not seen on the x-ray.

#### HOME CARE INSTRUCTIONS

To lessen the swelling, keep the injured part elevated while sitting or lying down. Keeping the injury above the level of your heart (the center of the chest) will decrease swelling and pain.

Apply ice to the injury for 20 minutes 4 times per day while awake for 2 days. Put the ice in a plastic bag and place a thin towel between the bag of ice and your cast.

If you have a plaster or fiberglass *cast*:

Do not try to scratch the skin under the cast using sharp or pointed objects.

Check the skin around the cast every day. You may put lotion on any red or sore areas.

Keep your cast dry and clean.

If you have a plaster *splint*:

Wear the splint as directed.

You may loosen the elastic around the splint if your fingers become numb, tingle, or turn cold or blue.

If you have been put in a removable splint, wear and use as directed.

Do not put pressure on any part of your cast or splint. It may break. Rest your cast or splint only on a pillow the first 24 hours until it is fully hardened.

Your cast or splint can be protected during bathing with a plastic bag. Do not lower the cast or splint into water.

Take medications as directed by your caregiver. Use acetaminophen (Tylenol®) or ibuprofen (Advil® or Motrin®) as needed for pain.

We care about you. Our goal is to treat your medical conditions, including pain, effectively, safely and in the right way.

Pain relief treatment can be complicated. Mistakes or abuse of pain medicine can cause serious health problems and death.

Our emergency department will only provide pain relief options that are safe and correct.

**For your SAFETY, we routinely follow these rules when helping you with your pain.**

1. We look for and treat emergencies. We use our best judgement when treating pain. These recommendations follow legal and ethical advice.
2. You should have only ONE provider and ONE pharmacy helping you with pain. We do not usually prescribe pain medication if you already receive pain medicine from another health care provider.
3. If pain prescriptions are needed for pain, we will only give you a limited amount.
4. We do not refill stolen or lost prescriptions for pain medication.
5. We do not prescribe long-acting pain medicines such as: OxyContin, MSContin, Fentanyl (Duragesic), Methadone, Opana ER, Exalgo, and others.
6. We do not provide missed doses of Methadone.
7. We do not usually give shots for flare-ups of chronic pain.
8. Health care laws, including HIPAA, allow us to ask for all of your medical records. These laws allow us to share information with other health providers who are treating you.
9. We may ask you to show a photo ID when you receive a prescription for pain medicines.
10. In California, we use the California Prescription Drug Monitoring Program called CURES. In Arizona and Nevada, we use the Prescription Monitoring Program that has oversight by the Arizona and Nevada state boards of pharmacy. These statewide computer systems track opioid pain medications and other controlled substance prescriptions.

On 02-22-2023 at approx. 2215 Hrs, I, Ofc. Nunez #512/RT32 responded to the 13th St LRS regarding an RT rail Unit who was standing by with a female who was requesting the fire department. Per updates, the female denied fire and was requested to be removed from RT property. I arrived on scene at approx. 2215 Hrs. With my body camera activated, I observed the following in summary:

Upon my arrival on scene, I made contact with the fire department on scene who advised the female did not have a chief complaint of pain and just wanted a ride to Carmichael.

Fire department left the scene and the female was asked to leave RT property. I asked and told the female she had to leave no less than 3 times. The female advised she had a all day pass which she attempted to locate. The female could not find her pass and was asked to leave RT property since she did not have valid fare. The female was then told 2 more times to grab her belongings and leave. The female continued to trespass on RT property and would not leave.

I grabbed the female's right arm and utilized a department approved control hold to attempt and get the female off of the RT ramp. I advised the female she had to grab her belongings and get off the RT ramp. While in a control hold, I gave the female an opportunity to grab her plastic bag which she did not do. She was then moved over to her blanket and was given an opportunity to grab her blanket which she did not do.

The female began flailing around and I let go of the female and gave her an opportunity to leave the station with her belongings.

The female stood there, yelling and crying and was refusing to leave.

I then grabbed the female's left arm and put her in a department approved 2 handed rear wrist lock. While walking down the ramp the female then threw herself onto the railing on my left hand side and continued screaming. She then used her body and threw herself to the ground while. I did not hear or feel a pop in her wrist or arm prior to her falling to the ground.

When she first went to the ground I pulled her up to a standing position and then she again threw herself to the ground and started moving around twisting her body on the ground. While laying on the ground, the female began screaming "you broke my arm" while moving her arm around. She also started yelling "you broke my wrist" while moving her arm and wrist around. I helped the female off of the ground and she began to thrash around and continued to yell. The female continued rolling around on the cement ground on the ramp while making incoherent sounds and noises. I did not observe any obvious injury to her arm or wrist.

Based on her movements while she was on the ground and how she was manipulating her arms and hands I did not believe her to have injured her arm or wrist. The female continued to state I broke her wrist and arm while rolling around and using her hands and arms without issue. While on the ground the female also stated that her feet were broken. I was able to stand the female up off the ground and gave her the jacket which she grabbed.

I moved the females property off of RT property in an attempt to get her out of the area. The female was concerned about retrieving her property and was shown where her property was. The female was running around and appeared to be under the influence of some sort of drug. The female was screaming erratically and I was not able to understand what she saying.

I would attempt to show the female where her property was and she would scream and would begin to run and walk around the station. While walking around the station she also appeared to be using the arm which she said was broken to hold her jacket giving the appearance that she was not injured.

Due to the female saying her arm was broken and wanted to go to the hospital, I, told her I would drive the female to the hospital multiple times since Fire had just cleared the call. She did not answer me and only stated that she wanted her belongings.

The female did not want to be transported and was only concerned about getting her belongings and she wanted to get on the train that would go to the Sunrise LRS.

The female then held her arm up while waving it around and said her arm hurt. I also asked the female if she wanted the Fire department to respond back out look at her arm and wrist 2 more times and she did not respond. I also asked her if her arm hurt and she said no. I still did not observe any obvious injury or deformities to the arm or wrist that would appear to be consistent with a broken arm.

A Sunrise bound train arrived on scene and I assisted the female with getting on train. While getting on the train, the female continued to yell while she boarded the train and sat down.

I then asked the female two more times, if she wanted to de board the train so I could contact the Fire department and the female said "You will not do that" with other words I was not able to understand.

The female was given her belongings and the RT employees and myself de boarded the train.

I made contact with RT30 Sgt. Buchanan on the phone due to him being off duty and advised him of the call.

After making contact with Sgt. Buchanan and determining that this incident was not a reportable use of force due to no observed injury at the time and only using a department approved control hold, no canvas was conducted.

Later at approx. 2359 Hours, Officer Hepler RT31 and I responded to the Watt / Manlove LRS regarding the same female who was requesting medical on the train.

Units responded and met the female on the train. The female was identified as [REDACTED], [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] appeared to have minor swelling to her left wrist and was not complaining of any pain due to her wrist and did not want fire to respond to the Watt and Manlove LRS. Officer Hepler and I did not observe any obvious deformities to the arm or wrist other than the minor swelling.

Then he picked up her bags nicely to help her and hand it to her. She just grabbed it out of his hands. He said lets go and she still refused. He grabbed her hand to try and help her leave the station. She was just trying to fall down on the ground. She started laying on the ground and moving around. After she was on the ground he helped her up. After that he picked up her stuff and offered to take her to the hospital, she still refused. We got her stuff and put it in the train and she headed towards Folsom.

She looked fine and she was moving. She just told them she wanted to go there for food and warmth. The officer picked up her bag to help her move but she forcibly grabbed it from him. He kind of tried to push (guide with hands) her along. Then he grabbed her arm and was holding her. It was the left arm he grabbed by the bicep (showed motion of one arm on the bicep and another at the hand). That's when she tried to fall down and was acting like she is hurt. She didn't calm down and was yelling and screaming. She was just moving around. When she was on the ground, Officer was not holding onto her. He just left her. The Officer was by himself. He asked her to get up and she wasn't getting up.

I grabbed her blanket and he grabbed her bag and she followed us. She got on the train and put her stuff next to her.

When he grabbed her arm, I don't know how forcibly he did it, but she wasn't complying. She was moving around. He tried to help her.

On Thursday 2-23-23, at approximately 1623 hours I, (Officer Gritskevich #921) contacted [REDACTED] via cell phone for a statement. He stated the following in summary:

There was a white lady, 4'-10 or 5'-00, 64 years old she claimed. She was possibly homeless and had belongings with her and a blue blanket wrapped around her. She was sitting there through several trains. I'm the rail supervisor and she is sitting on the Inbound ramp. I went over there and I questioned her. I said, where are you going? She said Mercy San Juan. I know that's way out in Carmichael and it's after 10pm. I knew she wasn't going to be able to make it out there on our system. I asked her a couple of times, do you need medical? She said I need to go to the hospital. Usually when they say they need to go to a hospital we give them directions to the nearest hospital. We can't do a taxi service.

I asked her again, if you're not going to move do you medical? She was refusing to leave the ramp. She was on top of the ramp (for disabled). I asked her if she needed medical and she said yes. Right at that moment, my protocol is to call Metro control and tell them she needs medical and that I'm standing by so I stood by. Fire department shows up and she said she just has [REDACTED] and needs to go to the hospital. They're not going to take her for that, that's what they told me. She still wouldn't leave the ramp. It escalated where she wouldn't follow their direction to get off the ramp. Police Services was called. I believe one of your units came by. I think it was Officer Nunez or something like that. I think his badge number was 512.

He dealt with her for quite some time. It was for 5, 10, or 15 minutes. It went on for a while. He finally got her to get down off the ramp. He didn't chase her around he was trying to encourage her to go this way or at least go somewhere where she would be out of the station. He ended up getting her to board the Outbound Gold line train heading towards Folsom at around 1030pm.

She headed out to Folsom and then the train operator reported over the radio that she was still on the train and the train was going Inbound and the police met her at Watt/Manlove and removed her from the train I believe.
