## TO: ALL EXISTING MONTHLY EV PARKING PASSHOLDERS AND CONTRACT ACCOUNTS

As a current Electric Vehicle (EV) monthly passholder at a City-owned parking facility, or a current parking contract customer with the City of Sacramento, our office is notifying you of a potential change to the EV parking program which is part of the City Manager's <a href="Proposed Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Budget">Proposed Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Budget</a>. Acceptance or rejection of any items of this proposal are determined by the Sacramento City Council.

The proposal is to assess EV charging fees for the use of any EV charging station located within all City parking facilities, including community centers, aquatic centers, and libraries.

This is not a change to the EV monthly parking rate or any contracted parking rate. This proposal only recommends an additional fee for the <u>use</u> of EV chargers. The additional EV Charging fee will only apply when a vehicle occupies an EV charging space. <u>California law requires that EV charging spaces are for the exclusive purpose of charging a vehicle that is connected for charging purposes.</u>

If this proposal is passed, then use of an EV charging station will require a separate payment at the following rates via the ChargePoint app. Rates are subject to change based on SMUD fees: -

- o SMUD Off-Peak Hours: \$0.20 per kWh
- o SMUD Mid-Peak Hours: \$0.25 per kWh
- SMUD Peak Hours: \$0.30 per kWh
- \$10/hour overstay fee assessed by ChargePoint on the membership account if the vehicle remains plugged in past the posted time limit at any City-owned facility

The City Council will conduct a final vote on all FY 24/25 budget proposals during the Council meeting on June 11, 2024 (5 p.m. session). Up through that date, any comments or concerns related to any part of the proposed budget may be expressed at City Council meetings, which are held every Tuesday at New City Hall. Comments are also accepted via the online eComment link that is located next to the "Agenda" link for that specific meeting date. If this proposal is passed on June 11<sup>th</sup>, then EV Charging fees will be implemented no less than 30 days from that date.
