In accordance with the annual reporting provisions contained in the Tax Allocation Loan Agreement CIEDB B05-065 dated June 1, 2006, ("Loan Agreement") between the City of Sacramento as Successor Agency to the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Sacramento and the Redevelopment Agency of the County of Sacramento ("Borrower") and the California Infrastructure and Economic Development Bank ("IBank"), any amendments thereto, and as modified by the letter from IBank dated December 28, 2012, I hereby certify that the following is true and correct for fiscal year 2021-22 ("Fiscal Year"). All capitalized terms have the same meaning as defined in the Loan Agreement.

- 1. Attached is a copy of the Borrower's audited financial statements for the Fiscal Year, prepared by an Independent Accountant. The City's Annual Comprehensive Financial Report for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2022 was provided under separate cover.
- 2. The total tax increment allocated by the County Assessor's Office for payment of the IBank debt (includes principal, interest, and IBank Annual Fee) for the Fiscal Year is: \$187,865.42 (for debt service payments on June 1, 2022 and December 1, 2022).
- 3. No Event of Default as described in Section 7.01(a) has occurred and no event has occurred which, with the passing of time or the giving of notice or of both, would constitute an Event of Default. **That is correct.**
- 4. The Borrower is in compliance with the Tax Certificate requirements as set forth in Exhibit G of the Agreement. In addition, the Purchaser certifies to the following:

- 6. The Borrower submitted all Recognized Obligation Payment Schedules (ROPS) required for the current Fiscal Year to the Department of Finance (DOF) according to DOF's schedule and the Borrower's ROPS payment schedules provided coverage for this loan and other obligations approved by DOF. Yes.
