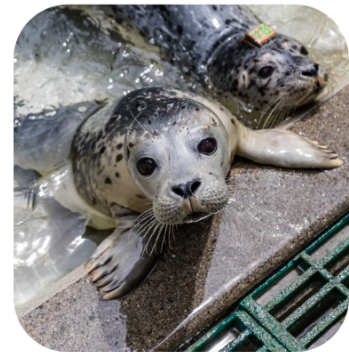


# Marine Mammal Center
